

# AMAZING ALMONDS

About 80% of the world's almonds come from California.

In 2017, California reached 1 million acres of almond cultivation.

It takes approximately two hives worth of bees to pollinate every acre of almond trees.

California's almond crop requires a total of around 80 billion insects in 1.7 million hives.

California's 7,600 growers churned out 2.26 billion pounds of almonds in 2018.

The average American consumes 2.7 pounds of almonds a year.
