APPLICATION INFORMATION SHEET

Ag Biz Planner Program Goals:

- Assist young, beginning, small and minority farmers in becoming more successful business people through knowledge of the marketplace, financial and business management topics.
- Teach valuable skills that will enable them to develop a useful, meaningful strategic business plan for their own business and help them become more responsible financial managers.
- Facilitate a close relationship through a mentor-based approach to learning.
- Provide a value-added service to customers by helping them better understand the lending process.

Participants:

Ag Biz Planner participants are encouraged to attend a Farm Management Institute which is held in the Spring of each year, have access to high-speed internet, and live/farm in the Farm Credit of the Virginias service area. Participants will either be the primary decision maker or have a major influence in decisions involving the farming or agribusiness operation.

Tuition: Tuition for Ag Biz Planner is \$500.

Upon acceptance into the program, each participant will be asked to pay the tuition cost of \$500. This course will begin in July 2023 and will conclude approximately six months from the start. The mentors involved with the program have two "checkpoints" set up for the program, which are mentioned throughout the application. Upon successful completion of the program and all deadline requirements, \$250.00 may be reimbursed in early 2024.

If a participant is in need of a computer in order to complete the program, please let us know on the application. We do not want the lack of owning or access to a computer to hinder or defer your enrollment in the program.

YBSM definitions (Applicants can meet one or more of the definitions posted below, but is NOT limited to the following descriptions.)

Young Farmers are defined as those farmers, ranchers, producers or harvesters of aquatic products who are age 35 or younger.

<u>Beginning Farmers</u> are defined as those farmers, ranchers, producers or harvesters of aquatic products who have 10 years or less farming or ranching experience.

<u>Small Farmers</u> are defined as those farmers, ranchers, producers or harvesters of aquatic products who normally generate less than \$250,000 in annual gross sales of agricultural or aquatic products.

<u>Minority Farmers</u> are defined as American Indian or Alaskan Native, Asian, Black or African American, Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, a person whose ethnicity is Hispanic or Latino regardless of race, and women.

<u>Veteran Farmers</u> are defined as those farmers who have served in the armed forces of the United States or reserves thereof.
