Christmas Tree

Almost all trees require shearing to attain the Christmas tree shape.



It takes 6 to 10 years of fighting heavy rain, wind, hail, and drought to get a mature tree.

An acre of Christmas trees provides the daily oxygen requirements of 18 people.

At 6 to 7 feet trees are ready for harvest.

Live Christmas trees have been sold commercially in the United States since about 1850.
