Digging in: Earthworms

Earthworms improve soil structure and enhance soil fertility.

Soil Structure


Worms burrow through the soil creating channels for air and water to flow through.

The burrowing loosens compacted soil and allows roots to grow deeper and access nutrients.

Soil Fertility

Worms eat and digest organic matter and leave behind "castings" which are nutrient-rich. Castings are full of nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium.
