Materials

- Products list
- Two different color highlighters
- More Than Just The... Infographics

Procedure

- Give each student a copy of the by-product list and two different color highlighters.
- Each student should use one highlighter to highlight every by-product they use within the first 24 hours of having the paper. After the first 24 hours, students should switch to the other highlighter and highlight everything they use on the list in the upcoming week.
 - o If you do not have highlighters for students, have them use a writing utensil and mark the products with symbols or D for daily and W for weekly.
- Once the week is over, have students use the "More Than Just The..." infographics to find out how many products they used from each product. Some products overlap!
