

# An E-Learning Course Designed for Young, Beginning, Small & Minority Farmers and Ranchers

#### **Ag Biz Planner Program Goals:**

- Assist young, beginning, small and minority farmers in becoming more successful business people through knowledge of the marketplace, financial and business management topics.
- Teach valuable skills that will enable them to develop a useful, meaningful strategic business plan for their own business and help them become more responsible financial managers.
- Facilitate a close relationship through a mentor-based approach to learning.
- Provide a value-added service to customers by helping them better understand the lending process.

#### PARTICIPANTS:

Ag Biz Planner participants are encouraged to attend a Farm Management Institute which are held in the Spring of each year, have access to high speed internet, and live/farm in the Farm Credit of the Virginias service area. Participants will either be the primary decision maker or have major influence in decisions involving the farming or agribusiness operation. Participants may be, but are not limited to, one of the following: brother and/or sister, husband and/or wife, business partners, family members or individual.

Tuition: Tuition for Ag Biz Planner is \$500.

**Upon acceptance into the program, each participant will be asked to pay the tuition cost of \$500**. This course will begin in August of 2021 and will conclude in January of 2022. The mentors involved with the program have two "checkpoints" set up for the program, which are mentioned throughout the application. Upon successful completion of the program and all deadline requirements, \$250.00 may be reimbursed in early 2022.

If a participant is in need of a computer in order to complete the program, please let us know on the application. We do not want owning or access to a computer hinder or defer your enrollment in the program.

YBSM definitions (Applicants can meet one or more of the definitions posted below, but is NOT limited to the following descriptions.)

**Young Farmers** are defined as those farmers, ranchers, producers or harvesters of aquatic products who are age 35 or younger.

**Beginning Farmers** are defined as those farmers, ranchers, producers or harvesters of aquatic products who have 10 years or less farming or ranching experience.

**Small Farmers** are defined as those farmers, ranchers, producers or harvesters of aquatic products who normally generate less than \$250,000 in annual gross sales of agricultural or aquatic products.

**Minority Farmers** are defined as American Indian or Alaskan Native, Asian, Black or African American, Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, a person whose ethnicity is Hispanic or Latino regardless of race, and women.
