



FORESTRY ACTIVITIES

Forestry Definition

- Materials
 - [History of Forestry and Forestry Definitions](#)
 - Forestry Definitions PowerPoint
 - Forestry Definition Bingo Board
 - Writing Utensil
 - Paper/notebook for notes
 - Optional: Bingo Chips
- Procedure
 1. Begin by going through the Knowledge Center's Forestry Definitions PowerPoint. The PowerPoint goes through 21 forestry vocabulary words that can be found in the Knowledge Center [History of Forestry and Forestry Definitions](#) blog. The PowerPoint highlights each vocabulary word one at a time so you can go at the pace that fits your classroom. There are 5-6 vocabulary words per slide. Students should be instructed to take notes.
 2. After going through the PowerPoint hand each student a blank forestry vocabulary bingo board. Instruct the students to pick 20 of the 21 vocabulary words to write in their boxes.
 3. After students have their bingo boards filled out read off different vocabulary definitions. Students should mark off the word that matches the description you read. Students can use their notes or not, whatever fits your classroom and teaching style!
