 - Notecard/Sticky notes
 - Way to hang note cards (tape, yarn and clothes hanger)
 - Writing utensil
 - Research Device
 - Procedure
 1. Have students read the Knowledge Center [History of Forestry and Forestry Definitions](#) blog and [History of Forestry](#) infographic.
 2. Each student should take a note card and either research their own event pertaining to the history of forestry or use an event that is listed on the infographic/blog. They should write down any pertinent information and the date(s) the event occurred.
 3. Students should then work together to create a walk through timeline by hanging their events in order.
 - When having students walk through you can have them take notes or share their event with the class
- ★ If individual student work fits your classroom better you can have students create their own timeline on a piece of paper or in a word document/PowerPoint to turn in!
