All About Strawberries

Materials

- Knowledge Center Strawberry Parts and Facts PowerPoint
- Strawberry Part Labels
- Strawberry Parts worksheet
- Tape
- Scissors
- Strawberries
- Toothpicks
- Butter knife
- Strawberry Crossword puzzle
- Chocolate (optional)

Procedure

- 1. Begin passing out Strawberry Parts worksheets to each students.
- 2. Go through the Knowledge enter Strawberry parts and Facts PowerPoint
- 3. Instruct students to write down the strawberry facts on the back of their worksheet along with the nutrition facts.
- 4. They should then write the definition for each strawberry part.
- 5. Then each student should receive a strawberry parts label set to cut out. They should only cut the dotted lines.
- 6. Then each students should receive a strawberry, six tooth picks, a butter knife, and tape. They should then label the parts of a strawberry.
 - If you are doing this as a Valentine's Day activity consider making chocolate covered strawberries. As a warm up exercise ask students to brainstorm what agricultural products are sold as gifts on Valentine's Day and what agricultural careers contribute to Valentine's Day.
- 7. Once students label their strawberry they can fill out the Strawberry crossword puzzle.
