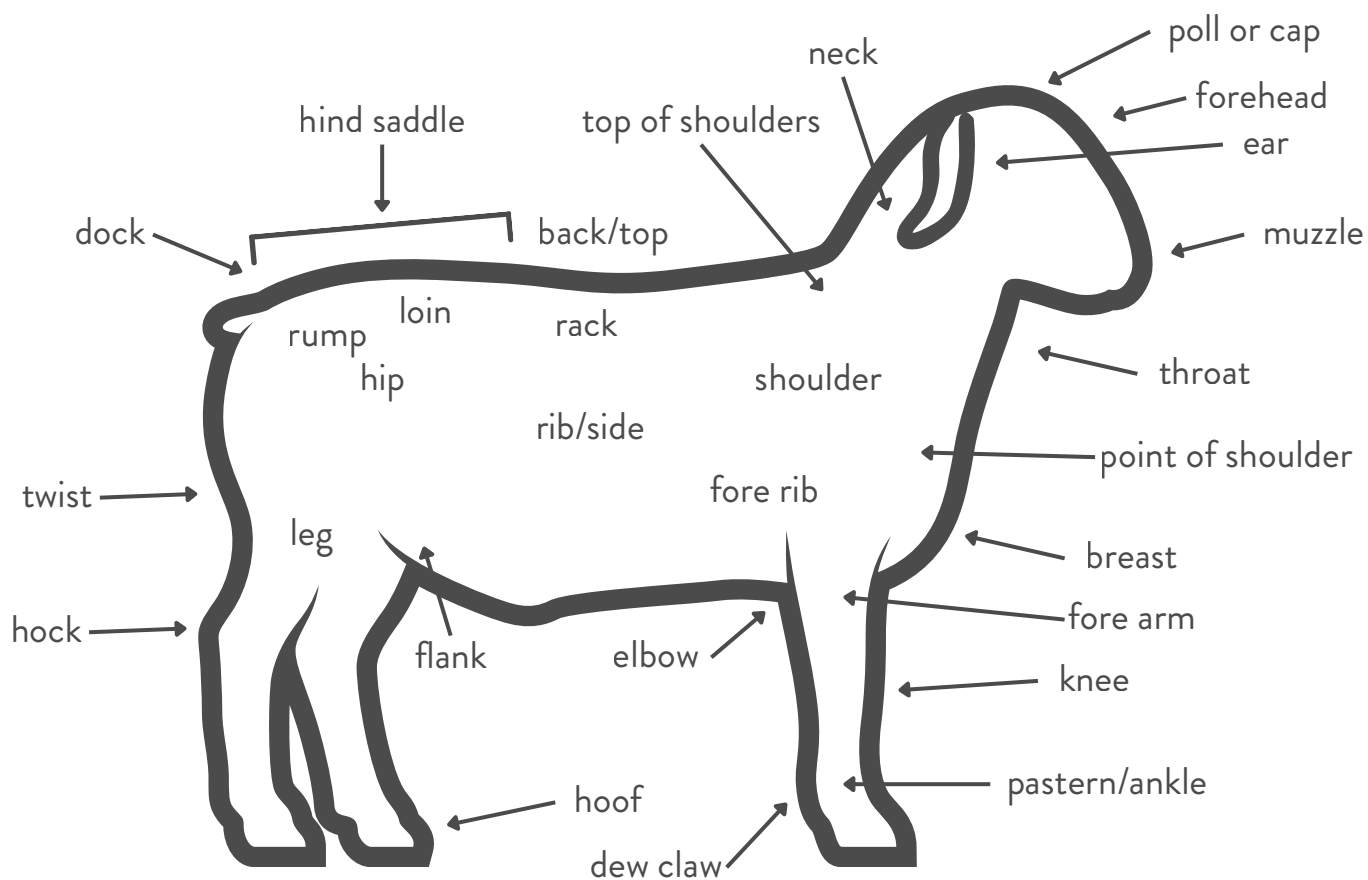




ANATOMY OF A LAMB

Fun Facts:

- **Docked Tails:** Lambs often have their tails docked (shortened) to prevent health issues like flystrike, which can occur if manure builds up around the tail.
- **Rib Shape Tells a Story:** Wide, well-sprung ribs indicate good body capacity and are a sign of a healthy, well-fed lamb.
- **Legs for Judging:** The leg, especially the hind leg, is one of the most valuable cuts of lamb and is closely examined in meat judging contests.
