


ANATOMY OF A LAMB

Let's examine the anatomy of a lamb.



7un 7acts:

- Docked Tails: Lambs often have their tails docked (shortened) to prevent health issues like flystrike, which can occur if manure builds up around the tail.
- Rib Shape Tells a Story: Wide, well-sprung ribs indicate good body capacity and are a sign of a healthy, well-fed lamb.
- Legs for Judging: The leg, especially the hind leg, is one of the most valuable cuts of lamb and is closely examined in meat judging contests.
