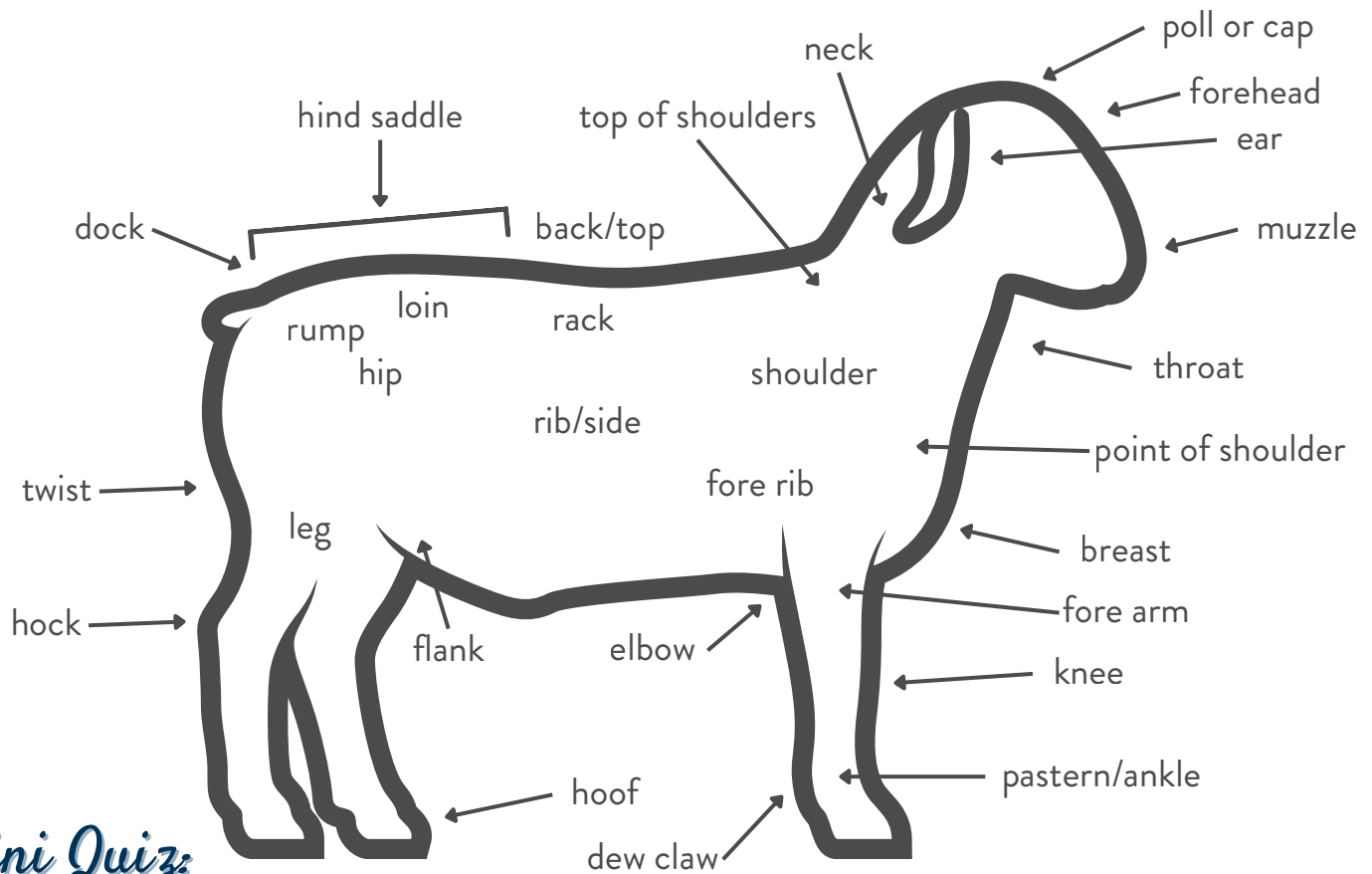




ANATOMY OF A LAMB
