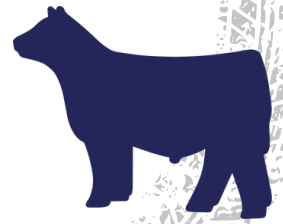
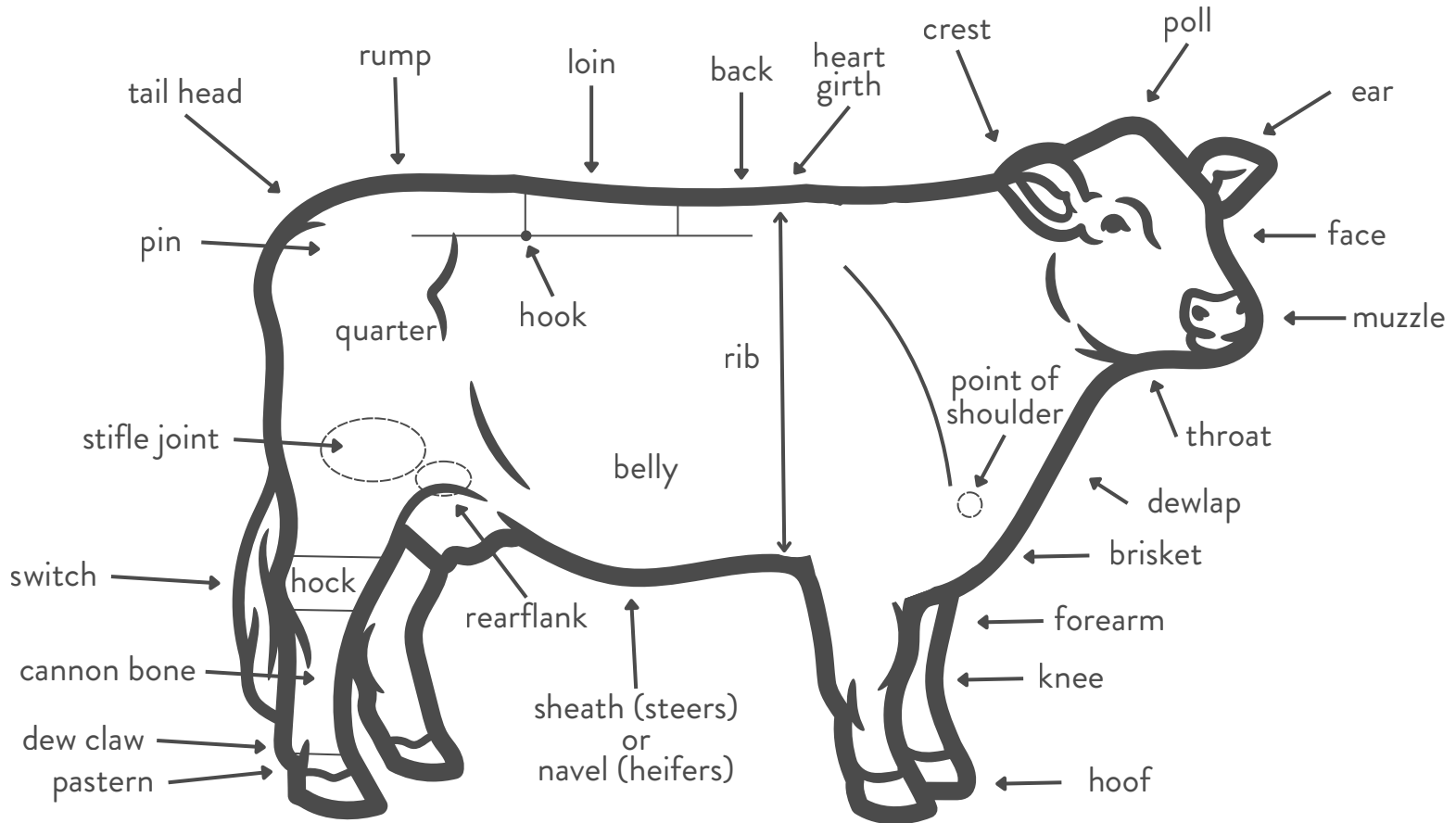




ANATOMY OF A STEER
